

IAPRD Educational Program in Ukraine 2018

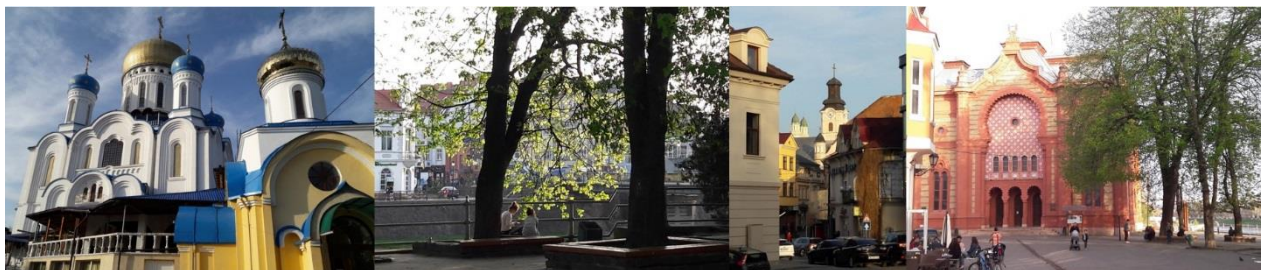
An **IAPRD Educational Program** entitled “Current Status of Clinical Practice in Movement Disorders” was held in **Uzhgorod, Ukraine**, in April 2018. The Program was organized by Prof. Alexander Pulyk at Uzhgorod National University, Postgraduate Education Faculty, Assoc. Prof. Andreas Puschmann, Lund University, Sweden, and Prof. Zbigniew Wszolek, Jacksonville, USA. The meeting was attended by about 70 neurologists, general practitioners and postgraduate students from the entire Transcarpathia Region in Western Ukraine. IAPRD international faculty were Elena Moro (Grenoble, France), Irena Rektorová (Brno, Czech Republic) and Christer Nilsson (Lund, Sweden). After presentations on various aspects of movement disorders within the presenters’ areas of expertise, specialist neurologists from Uzhgorod presented patients with rare or unusual movement disorders that were discussed together.
